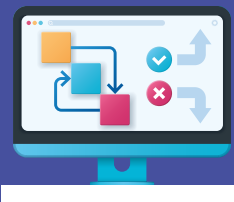

Integrated software platforms that are specifically designed for property management will streamline Health and Safety compliance processes, allowing for efficient management and monitoring.

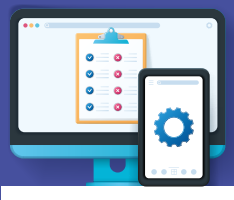

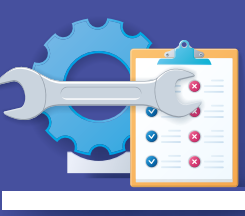
